

According to the Circular Letter of the Directorate General of Immigration No. IMI-0533.GR.01.01 of 2022 concerning the Ease of Immigration to Support Sustainable Tourism in the Area of Bintan during the COVID-19 Pandemic, as of 22 March 2022, the Indonesian government has added countries and special entities whose citizens can enter Bintan that with Visa Exemption and Visa On Arrival (VOA) for leisure purpose.

Below are the countries that are subject to the Visa Exemption for Leisure Purpose:

Visa Exemption or Visa on Arrival for Leisure Purpose in the areas of Bintan can be granted with following requirements:

- Passport that is still valid for a minimum of 6 (six) months,
- A return ticket or a one-way ticket to continue the trip to another country,
- Proof of ownership of health insurance,
- Proof of accommodation confirmation, and
- Permanent Resident Singapore (PR), except for Singapore nationals

The Stay Permits of Free Visa facility are granted for a maximum period of 14 days without extension. As for VOA, the Stay Permits are granted for a maximum period of 30 days and can be extended 1 (one) time.
