Visa Exemption or Visa on Arrival for Leisure Purpose in the areas of Bintan can be granted with following requirements:

- Passport that is still valid for a minimum of 6 (six) months,
- A return ticket or a one-way ticket to continue the trip to another country,
- Proof of ownership of health insurance,
- Proof of accommodation confirmation, and

The Stay Permits of Free Visa facility are granted for a maximum period of 30 days without extension. As for VOA, the Stay Permits are granted for a maximum period of 30 days and can be extended 1 (one) time.
